Leukaemia Immunophenotyping and Diagnostic Interpretation (Accredited)

As part of the continual development of our External Quality Assessment (EQA) services we are redesigning this programme to better reflect current hospital laboratory testing protocols.

Electronic Flow Cytometry Educational Trials

These provide valuable information on analysis of flow cytometry data by clinical laboratory scientists. UK NEQAS LI will continue to deliver and expand electronic data EQA exercises alongside the existing flow cytometry programmes.

Updates to website data entry fields such that recording of antibody clones is possible, tying in with proposed improvements to PNH reports to recognise and promote best practice whilst highlighting non-compliance with the 2018 ICCS/EDCCA consensus guidelines.
